eConveyancing Consultation Feedback

The Office of the Registrar-General would like to thank participants who attended the Future of eConveyancing Forum (the Forum) at the Adelaide Convention Centre on 22 August 2018, and respondents to the online survey on the same topic. Subscribers were notified of both consultation opportunities via CIB 315.

Ticket allocations for the Forum were exhausted with 131 registrants from across the industry attending on the day to actively engage and provide their views on what the future of eConveyancing should look like in South Australia. The online survey attracted 176 responses, with many responders taking the time to offer insightful feedback, which was greatly appreciated.

The Office of the Registrar-General has collated both the survey results and comments provided by forum attendees on three options presented to them regarding the future of eConveyancing into a [Stakeholder Feedback Report](#) (the Report). Responses to several questions that were raised during the Forum panel Q&A session but were not answered due to time constraints are also included in the Report.
