The Future of eConveyancing

The Office of the Registrar-General is currently undertaking a consultation program with stakeholders on the future of eConveyancing in South Australia.

The purpose of this Customer Information Bulletin is to:

- inform you of the results of consultation already undertaken, and
- invite you to contribute to the consultation program through an online survey and a half-day forum.

In an initial consultation process, the Office of the Registrar-General received feedback from 27 stakeholders via email, teleconference and in-person engagement sessions. The results of this engagement process have been consolidated into a Stakeholder Consultation Report (the Report), which is now published online at www.sa.gov.au

We invite you to complete a brief and anonymous <u>multiple choice survey</u> on the topic of eConveyancing.

You are also invited to attend a half-day forum on Wednesday 22 August from 1pm – 5pm, at the Adelaide Convention Centre. The forum will include a review of feedback from the survey and initial engagement process, small group discussions, a panel Q&A session and an opportunity to have your say on the preferred model of eConveyancing for South Australia into the future.
