Expressions of Interest – Land Services SA and Office of the Registrar-General Advisory Group

Land Services SA (LSSA) and the Office of the Registrar-General (ORG) wish to announce the establishment of a stakeholder advisory group in 2019, and call for expressions of interest in membership from industry.

The LSSA ORG Advisory Group (the Advisory Group) will be co-chaired by the Registrar-General, Jenny Cottnam, and the CEO LSSA, Brenton Pike. The Advisory Group will not be a decision-making body, but rather an open, consultative body for the purposes of advice and clarification. Feedback from the Advisory Group will be used as part of decision-making processes by both LSSA and the ORG.

It is envisaged that the Advisory Group will consider a wide range of matters, including but not limited to:

- Consulting on the development of policy and legislative changes affecting land transactions in South Australia by ORG;
- Clarifying and advising on LSSA administration and procedures, including land registry forms;
- Advising on, and clarifying eConveyancing updates, as well as conducting follow-up consultation on implementation;
- Advising on, and clarifying compliance requirements and auditing regimes.

Meetings will be held bi-monthly on the first Wednesday of the relevant month, and as otherwise required. The first meeting is scheduled for 12:30 – 1:30pm Wednesday 6 February 2019.
