

CIRCULAR

TO SOLICITORS, LICENSED LAND BROKERS AND OTHER LODGING PARTIES

Full and Temporary withdrawal of instruments from registration

Your attention is directed to Note 2, page 319 in the $\underline{\text{fifth}}$ edition of "Forms and Practice".

For the benefit of those who have earlier editions, the Note, as amended, is set out hereunder:

"2. The Broker, Solicitor, or party lodging must make this application WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PARTY DERIVING BENEFIT UNDER THE TRANSACTION".

This Office is now insisting that this consent be obtained, and it may either be endorsed on the application to withdraw or attached thereto. In the latter case suitable identification of the instrument will have to be made.

Your concurrence with this requirement is requested in order to avoid rejection of applications.
