Model Operating Requirements and Model Participation Rules - Version 6

The consultation period for the Model Operating Requirements (MOR) and Model Participation Rules (MPR) Version 6 closed on 2 March 2020. The Australian Registrars' National Electronic Conveyancing Council (ARNECC) received a significant volume of feedback on the consultation drafts.

I appreciate the time and effort undertaken by stakeholders in providing their comments on the proposed amendments.

Given the recent impacts of COVID-19, ARNECC has released a [Notice to Stakeholders](#) advising of its intent to no longer:

- include the proposed amendment to the VOI regime requiring Subscribers to first apply the VOI standard prior to utilising reasonable steps as part of MPR Version 6
- apply the original implementation timeline as presented at the February 2020 industry forums, which proposed a take-effect date of 3 August 2020 for both MOR and MPR Version 6. It is now unlikely that a take-effect date will be implemented in 2020.

ARNECC will review and advise of an updated implementation timeline once the impacts of COVID-19 are clearer. In the meantime, should you require any further information or have any specific questions relating to the above, please email them directly to chair@arnecc.gov.au.
