PANEL FORMS

A2 - APPLICATION TO REGISTER DEATH

The information contained in these notes is to be read in conjunction with "GENERAL NOTES RELATING TO PANEL FORMS".

NOTES.

Instructional notes contained on the form must be read carefully before attempting to complete the information required in the panels.

CERTIFICATES OF TITLE BEING AFFECTED.

In this panel insert "The whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title (or Crown Lease, Limited Title as the case may be) Register Book Volume Folio"

ESTATE AND INTEREST.

Note 2 on the form gives instructions on how to complete this panel. If as mortgagee (or Lessee) show - "As mortgagee (or Lessee) under and by virtue of Memorandum of Mortgage (or Lease) No.".

Should the deceased have held, for example, both "fee simple" and "mortgagee" estates, show as "FIRSTLY - in fee simple" and "SECONDLY - as mortgagee etc.". The Certificates of Title would correspondingly be shown.

DECEASED JOINT TENANT.

The instructions given in NOTE 3 are to be adhered to when completing the panel showing the deceased joint tenant.

The identity of the deceased as shown in the Certificate of Death, Probate or Letters of Administration and in the Certificate of Title no longer needs to be established by means of a Statutory Declaration.

This innovation will remove the necessity for individuals to declare the identity of the deceased before a Justice of the Peace etc. and will allow Trustee Companies to identify the deceased without recourse to a separate declaration by its Secretary.

APPLICANT.

The full name, address and occupation of the applicant is to be shown in this panel and identified with the Register Book as "formerly"; if necessary.


If the Executor of a deceased surviving joint tenant is the applicant, then add after his name, address and occupation "the executor of now deceased vide Probate dated".

EXECUTION AND PROOF.

The procedure affecting the execution and proof of signature is unaltered with the exception that the full name of the applicant will not be required in the execution clause or proof. Merely substitute "applicant" in these places for the name.

The form of execution by a Trustee Company is unaltered.
