## Surveyor-General's Cadastral Integrity Audit & Compliance Framework and Reissued Cadastral Survey Guidelines

---

### Surveyor-General's Audit & Compliance Framework

The South Australian Government, through the Attorney-General and the Surveyor-General, is responsible for issuing, monitoring and policing cadastral survey practice standards in South Australia.

The Surveyor-General has established a Cadastral Integrity, Audit & Compliance Framework that sets out the processes and procedures to assist licensed surveyors with regulatory compliance. It sets the overarching approach to compliance and establishes the principles for how regulatory functions are undertaken and monitored.

### Cadastral Survey Guidelines Reissue

A new version (v5.0) of the Cadastral Survey Guidelines (CSG) has been issued by the Surveyor-General and is available for download from the [Office of the Surveyor-General website](#).

Amendments to the CSG include:

- Updated contact details
- Links to new online forms for the Provision of Permanent Survey Mark (PSM) Coordinates, PSM Coordinate Error Reports and Notification of Final Marking
- Section 5 - Date of Gazettal and Date of Operation (16/12/2021) for new DSAs 533 – 565
- Section 13.4c - Requirement for the Positional Uncertainty for PSM coordinates provided not to exceed 0.049m in urban areas and 0.099m in rural areas
- Section 13.4d - Clarification of requirements for PSMs used as the plan bearing datum
- Removal of the Section relating the Audit Surveys; replaced by the Audit & Compliance Framework document.
- Removal of Attachment 3 Section 10 - Table of Instrument Manufacturer's Specification for EDM calibration software. These specifications are stored and prepopulated within the software.
