Model Operating Requirements and Model Participation Rules Consultation– Version 7

Model Operating Requirements

In July 2021, ARNECC released the Model Operating Requirements (MOR) Version 7 Consultation Draft introducing requirements to support interoperability in electronic conveyancing. That consultation period closed on 11 August 2021.

ARNECC has now completed its review of the industry feedback received and made further amendments based on the matters raised. As a result, ARNECC has decided to undertake a second round of industry consultation before reaching a final determination for Version 7 of the MOR. [MOR – Consultation Draft 7.1](#) is now available on the ARNECC website for review.

To enable you to fully consider this second round of proposed changes, both a marked up and clean version of the Consultation Draft has again been published. In addition, a [Feedback Table](#) providing substantial information and outlining the action taken in response to the submissions received during the first round of consultation has also been published.



ARNECC has now completed its review of the industry feedback and made further amendments based on the matters raised. Due to the limited volume and nature of the feedback received, ARNECC will not be issuing a second Consultation Draft of the MPR.
