

Expressions of Interest (membership): for the 2021 Land Titling Advisory Group

Background

In late 2018, the Office of the Registrar-General (ORG) and Land Services SA (LSSA) established the Land Titling Advisory Group (LTAG), and held the first meeting in 2019.

The inaugural term of membership has now expired and this Bulletin is to advise that ORG and LSSA are seeking expressions of interest for the second term of LTAG membership.

The LTAG is not a decision-making body, but rather an open, consultative body for the purposes of two-way advice and clarification. Feedback from the LTAG is used as part of decision-making processes by both LSSA and the ORG.

The LTAG considers a wide range of matters including, but not limited to:

- Consulting on the development of policy and legislative changes affecting land transactions in South Australia
- Clarifying and advising on LSSA administration and procedures, including land registry forms
- Advising on and clarifying eConveyancing updates, as well as conducting follow-up consultation on implementation
- Advising on and clarifying compliance requirements and auditing regimes
