## Updates to the PIR on Code Amendments

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### **Changes to the Property Interest Report (PIR) for Code Amendments that are on consultation**

A new page on the PlanSA portal has been developed to include Code Amendments via the following link [https://plan.sa.gov.au/have\\_your\\_say/general\\_consultations](https://plan.sa.gov.au/have_your_say/general_consultations). This page provides information on Code Amendments initiated, on consultation, consultation completed and finalised.

Under the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* the following designated entities can initiate a Code Amendments:

- State Planning Commission
- State agencies
- a council or joint planning board
- infrastructure providers
- a person who has an interest in the land (private proponent)

When a Code Amendment is on consultation by the relevant designated entity it will be displayed in the PIR as either a Statewide interest or against the relevant LGA. When the Minister has made a decision and approved the Code Amendment it will be end dated and removed from the PIR.
