Extension to consultation period ARNECC Discussion Paper: Security-related obligations under the electronic conveyancing regulatory framework

I wish to advise ARNECC has extended the consultation period for the <u>Security-related Obligations</u> <u>under the electronic Conveyancing Regulatory Framework discussion paper</u>.

ARNECC recently issued the Discussion Paper on security-related matters affecting ELNOs and Subscribers to seek stakeholders' views on the matters raised. Recognising the importance of these issues ARNECC are seeking this input before any potential amendments to the regulatory framework are considered. At this stage, no decision has been taken to amend the framework on the matters discussed.

ARNECC will consider all feedback received through this consultation and will then decide whether changes should be made to the regulations. If ARNECC decides that changes may be required, it will then consult on those proposed changes by publishing consultation drafts of the MORs and the MPRs and again seeking comment from its stakeholders.

The extended consultation period will now end at 5:00pm (Australian Eastern Standard Time) Friday, 13 December 2024.
