Calls for submissions IPART methodology paper: IPART Review of ELNO Service Fees

I wish to advise that the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) has released a methodology paper as part of its [Review of Electronic Lodgment Network Operator \(ELNO\) service fees](#).

IPART is seeking stakeholder feedback on its proposed approach to establishing an initial asset base for an efficient ELNO. The initial asset base is a key component of the building block framework used to determine service fees.

The methodology paper outlines a proposed cost-based approach, considers alternative methodologies and seeks feedback from stakeholders before IPART develops its draft recommendations for ELNO service fees.

IPART will consider all submissions received before progressing to the next stage of the review.
