GUIDANCE NOTES - PANEL FORM DOCUMENT

ALTERATION TO "APPLICATION TO REGISTER MARRIAGE" NOTES

Lodging Parties should please note the following variations relating to the preparation of Applications to Register Marriage:-

1. Note 3 of Appendix B of Guidance Notes issued 15.7.1980 re Application to Register Marriage should now be disregarded.
2. The notes relating to ESTATE AND INTEREST panel should now read:-

ESTATE AND INTEREST

See Note 4 on the Form.

If as Mortgagee (or Lessee) show - "As Mortgagee (or Lessee) under and by virtue of Memorandum of Mortgage (or Lease) No....."

If the husband is registered jointly (or as Tenant in Common) with the applicant show - "Estate in fee simple jointly (or as Tenant in Common) with"

N.B. only include the name of the husband where he is registered jointly or as a tenant in common.

3. In lieu of the note "THE APPLICANT HEREBY APPLIES etc....." please now substitute the following:-
THE APPLICANT HEREBY APPLIES
Add "To have her marriage to of (although no longer obligatory it is desirable to show the current address and occupation of the husband, and if he is registered jointly, or as a tenant in common, then add "to the above named of"), which marriage is evidenced by the attached certified copy of Certificate of Marriage, noted on the Certificate of Title for the land above described".

N.B. It is no longer necessary, nor desirable, for the address and occupation of the husband shown on the Marriage Certificate to be included.

This is all that is required under normal circumstances. However, variations will occur where the husband is shown incorrectly either on the Certificate of Marriage or Certificate of Title (or both). See Appendix "B" for some variations and examples of how the husband can be identified.
