Closure and Joins Report available for Survey Industry.

The Closure and Joins Report is available for Survey Industry users within Digital Plan Lodgement. This report enables industry to validate the closure and joins of a plan prior to lodgement, reducing requisitions to save you time and money.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Closure and Joins Report is integrated into the Digital Plan Lodgement module within SAILIS, and works seamlessly as part of the existing workflow of preparing a plan for lodgement.

Once the draft plan (in DWG File format) has been uploaded in DPL, the system will run and prepare the Plan Presentation Requirements (PPR) and CAD Standards Validation Report for download. At the same time, it will prepare a new "Diagram" tab in the DPL workspace, which will contain the relevant data to indicate that the parcels and joins between survey marks are accurate and mathematically acceptable.

Within the "Diagram" tab of the DPL workspace, you will be able to see both a textual and a graphical representation of your plan. The graphical representation will draw the file showing comparisons within the tertiary network coordinates to assist you to quickly identify where:

- the data is correct, or requires amendment
- there are gaps in the linework

This new functionality provides significant benefit to the Industry:

- Graphical representation of data to support ease of interpretation
- Ability to validate polygons, parcels, lines and points prior to lodgement to reduce requisitions
- Ability to verify the data within the report without the need to re-load the DWG File

Reduced requisitions, not only save you time and money, but will improve the processing times for your plan approval.
