Model Operating Requirements Version 7 Consultation Draft

As you may be aware, there has been significant work being undertaken to enable a competitive marketplace in relation to electronic conveyancing. This work has focused on interoperability between Electronic Lodgement Network Operators

To support this work ARNECC has released the Model Operating Requirements (MOR) Version 7 Consultation Draft on the ARNECC website. In response to previous stakeholder feedback, ARNECC has also published explanatory notes outlining the reasoning for making the key proposed amendments

As indicated in the draft MOR, ARNECC is still considering a few of the provisions and will aim to finalise these amendments in conjunction with this consultation process. ARNECC is also preparing updates to the Model Participation Rules, which will be consulted on with stakeholders separately.

In order to meet the timeframe to enable the first interoperable electronic conveyancing transaction, please be advised that no extension to this initial consultation period will be provided.
