REGULATIONS UNDER THE BILLS OF SALE ACT 1886

The Bills of Sale Act (Paper for Instruments) Regulations 1984 will be revoked and new requirements have been prescribed under Section 38A of the Bills of Sale Act 1886, in relation to the paper on which Bills of Sale and other instruments lodged with the Registrar-General under that Act are prepared.

The new requirements which will come into operation on 1 September 1995 are as follows:

- (a) the paper must be A4 size (210 millimetres in width and 297 millimetres in length); and
- (b) the weight of the paper must be at least 80 grams per square metre; and
- (c) the paper must not be discoloured or have any other defect.

There will be a grace period of six months from this date for clients to exhaust current supplies of B4 forms.

Clients are reminded that no change has been made to the witnessing provisions of the Bills of Sale Act, i.e. the name, address and occupation of every attesting witness must be given.
