

Adoption of Digital Plan Lodgement

Notice to Lodging Party 245 NTLP) advised industry that from 4 April 2022 all plans able to be lodged through the Electronic Plan lodgement (EPL) System will be required to be lodged as CAD DWG files prepared to a published CAD Standard.

The CAD Standard and example drawings are published on the DPL page on the Land Services SA (LSSA) website https://www.landservices.com.au/businesses-and-property-industry-professionals/land-division/lodging-plans/digital-plan-lodgement. Land Services SA (LSSA) is also providing Industry with a suite of CAD Tools to assist in adopting the standard.

Since the launch, LSSA has been progressively contacting survey organisations to offer support in adopting the CAD Standard. Support is being provided in the form of demonstrations of the CAD Tools, explanation of EPL upload and validation reporting functionality, compliance checking of DWG files and general queries.

Over the last 6 months a significant number of organisations have utilised LSSA's offer for training and support, and as a result lodgement levels of DWG files have been steadily increasing.

LSSA is currently making available a resource whose primary role is to support Industry in the adoption of the CAD Standard.

Whilst this resource is available, I encourage those members of the survey industry that are yet to transition to the lodgement of DWG files to contact LSSA for access to the CAD Tools and support if required.
