Extended Bushfire Relief Measures

Background

In [CIB 341](#), issued on 30 March 2020, the Office of the Registrar-General and Land Services SA announced a program of fee relief to assist property owners affected by the bushfires. It was also noted that Revenue SA are providing relief on stamp duty for impacted property owners.

Update

Revenue SA has recently advised in [Revenue Ruling SDALT001\[V2\]](#) that it will extend the scope of stamp duty relief that is offered, to provide once only ex gratia stamp duty relief for those impacted by the bushfires who purchase vacant land on which a replacement home will be built within 3 years from the date of purchase.

The Office of the Registrar-General with Land Services SA will offer aligned relief in relation to the registration fees which accompany these approved transactions.


It should be noted that whilst the scope is being extended, the eligibility and requirements to seek relief remain as detailed in [CIB 341](#).

The relief program, including extended relief measures will remain available up to 20 January 2024.
