Further extension to the expiry of the COVID-19 Emergency Response Act 2020 and Section 16 Regulations

Background

<u>NTLP 230</u> advised that the Government of South Australia introduced the <u>COVID-19 Emergency</u> <u>Response Act 2020</u> (COVID-19 Act) to make various temporary amendments of the law of the State, including the <u>Real Property Act 1886</u> (RPA), in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Extension of the COVID-19 Emergency Response Act 2020

These temporary measures have now been further extended by amendment to the COVID-19 Act and are now due to expire on <u>31 May 2021</u>, or 28 days after the day on which all the relevant declarations relating to the outbreak of the human disease named COVID-19 have ceased, whichever is earlier (unless a date is otherwise fixed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette in accordance with section 6 of the COVID-19 Act).

Extension of the COVID-19 Emergency Response (Section 16) Regulations 2020

The COVID-19 Act amendment means the <u>COVID-19 Emergency Response (Section 16) Regulations</u> <u>2020</u> relating to statutory declarations, execution of corresponding mortgage and witnessing requirements (as detailed in <u>NTLP 237</u>) have therefore also been extended.

Verification of Identity Standard

Advice issued in <u>NTLP 230</u> relating to Verification of Identity Standard amendments, will continue to be applicable for the period in which the COVID-19 Act is operable (now extended), unless revoked earlier.
