

Model Participation Rules Version 7 Consultation Draft

As you may be aware, significant work has been undertaken to enable a competitive marketplace in relation to electronic conveyancing. This work has focused on interoperability between Electronic Lodgement Network Operators.

To support this work, ARNECC has released the Model Participation Rules (MPR) Version 7 Consultation Draft on the ARNECC website. In response to previous stakeholder feedback, ARNECC has also published explanatory notes outlining the reasoning for making the key proposed amendments.

As previously advised, ARNECC has also prepared updates to the Model Operating Requirements, which are available on the ARNECC website and open for consultation until 11 August 2021.
