2023 & 2024 Land Titling Advisory Group Membership

Background

The Land Titling Advisory Group (LTAG) was jointly established in 2018 by Land Services SA (LSSA) and the Office of the Registrar-General (ORG) to create a long-term communication channel between property industry stakeholders, LSSA and the ORG.

The LTAG is not a decision-making body. It aims to ensure transparent stakeholder consultation which enables members to raise issues and concerns, and seek clarification on a range of relevant matters.

Feedback from the LTAG is used to inform the decision-making processes of both LSSA and the ORG and also enables them to advise and collaborate on changes relevant to industry. Members are expected to communicate and share information from the LTAG with their colleagues and relevant stakeholders.

Membership in the LTAG is for a term of two years and the current term expires at the end of 2022.

The LTAG has to date considered a wide range of matters including, but not limited to:

- Consulting on the development of policy and legislative changes affecting land transactions in South Australia;
- Clarifying and advising on LSSA administration and procedures, including land registry forms;
- Advising on and clarifying eConveyancing updates, as well as conducting follow-up consultation on implementation; and
- Advising on and clarifying compliance requirements and auditing regimes.
