Changes to Panel Forms

In October 2023 Notice to Lodging Parties No. 260 was published, which outlined several changes to panel forms. A four-month transition period was in place from October 2023 and will come to a close on the 1/03/2024.

All paper panel forms dated on, or after, 1/03/2024 should be prepared using the latest version of the forms.

Further Mandating of eConveyancing in South Australia

In December 2023 Notice to Lodging Parties No. 261 was published, which outlined the further mandating of eConveyancing in South Australia.

This mandate will take effect from Monday 8 April 2024, after which all in-scope electronic lodgements will be required to be lodged via an approved ELNO in South Australia.

Some exemptions will apply where it is still necessary to lodge paper dealings, including transitionary exemptions for inflight transactions. Land Services SA (LSSA) will continue to update and maintain the exemptions list, which is accessible via its electronic conveyancing webpage https://www.landservices.com.au/landregistration/electronic-conveyancing
