Registrar-General's Industry Survey 2023

Background

On 3 August 2020, the electronic lodgement (eConveyancing) of in-scope dealings became mandatory in South Australia. On 25 August 2021, being one year after the in-scope dealings became mandatory in South Australia, I issued an industry survey on eConveyancing.
